GREECE

SOUTH AFRICA

Specifically in Hillbrow, the new year is rung in by chucking old furniture out the window. This can be a bit dangerous in areas of high-rise buildings.

POLAND

Carp, a fish eaten as the main dish on Christmas Eve in Poland, is believed to bring good luck. Many keep a carp scale in their wallet as a "magnet for cash."

GERMANY

"Lead pouring" (das Bleigießen) uses molten lead like tea leaves to predict the future. It is often done on new years for the coming year.




COVID-19 GLOBAL STATISTICS

COVID-19 Update

The Omicron variant has since become a global issue of concern. Our offices, especially in our Cape Town location, have felt the impacts of the emergence of a new variant already. The Omicron variant is still being studied by scientists and researchers to find out more, but here is what we do know as of right now.

What is the Omicron variant?

The Omicron variant is a new variant of the COVID-19 virus. Looking at the variant itself shows that the number of mutations could be considered a cause for concern. The WHO declared the Omicron variant as a "Variant of Concern" for this very reason.

Where is the Omicron variant?

The Omicron variant quickly spread across the globe upon its discovery in late November of 2021. It is now the dominant variant on a global scale and can be found in 68 countries, including South Africa, Spain, Greece, The United States, Germany, and France.

What are the characteristics of the variant?

The Omicron variant is able to spread at a rapid pace and has been found to be more transmissible than the Delta variant. However, despite Omicron's ability to spread rapidly, the severity of the illness proves to be weaker than the Delta variant. The symptoms caused by the variant are comparable to that of other variants: fever or chills, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, body and muscle aches, headaches, loss of taste/smell, congestion/runny nose, and nausea/vomiting.

Do vaccines help protect against the Variant?

The vaccine has shown positive results in combating the Omicron variant, especially for those who have received a booster shot. Those that are vaccinated and still contract a breakthrough case can expect mild symptoms if any at all. However, for the unvaccinated, the variant can severely impact you if contracted.

Extra COVID-19 Updates:

There has been a recent discovery of the B.1.640.2, or IHU, Variant in France. The WHO has yet to recognize this new variant. However, the IHU Variant has a number of mutations that could result in the WHO also declaring it as a Variant of concern.
