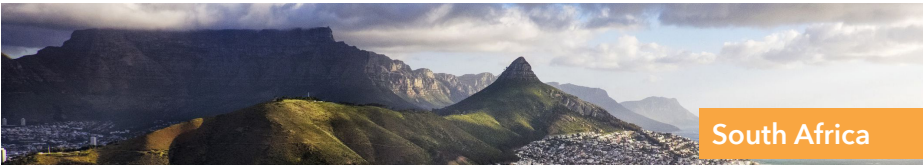

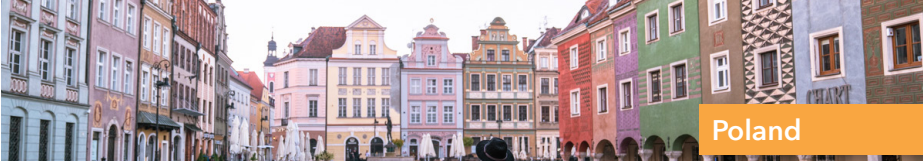

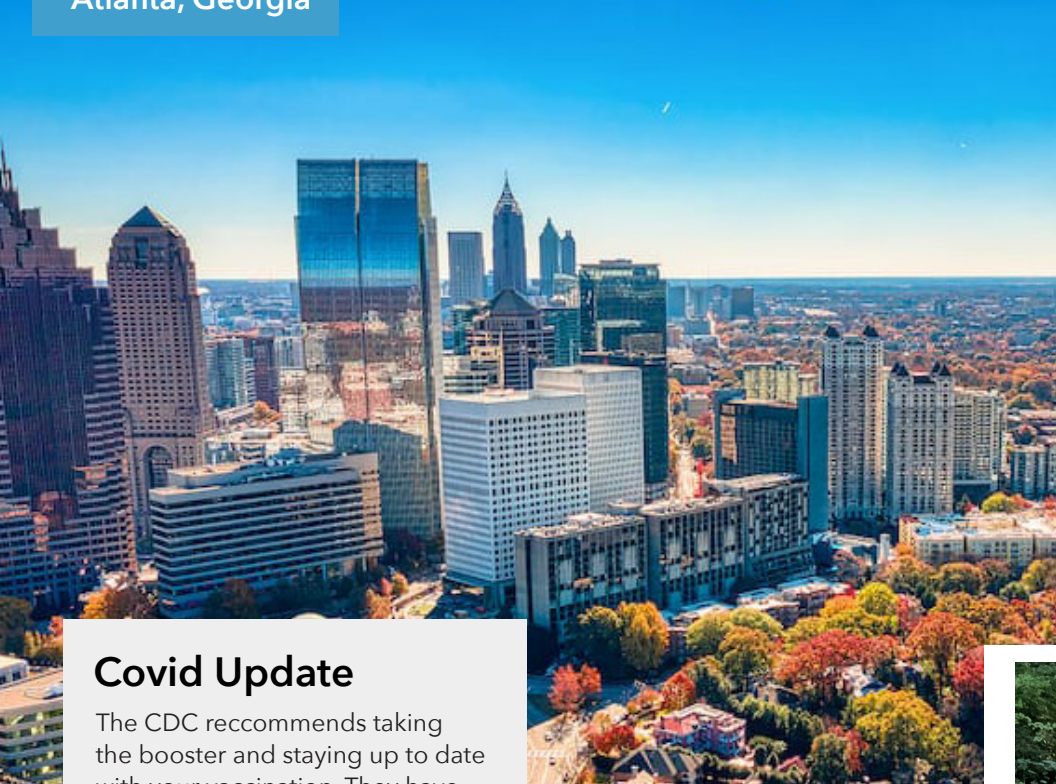
Anniversary Celebration

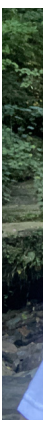
Covid Update

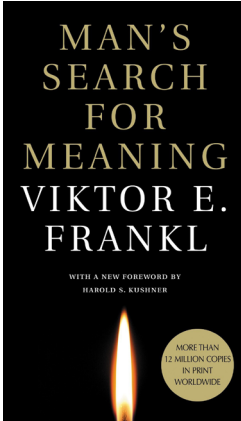
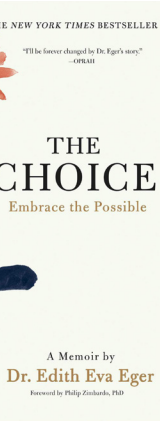

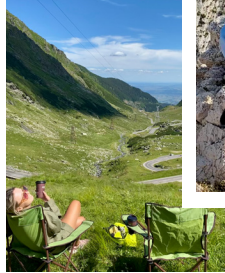

Vilnius – Vienna – Nice – Cannes – Berlin – Chemnitz – Bad Schandau – Dresden are the cities where I lived since last February. It could be a dreamlike lifestyle if not the reason that caused this adventure. I was lucky enough to leave Ukraine a couple of days before the war started. I didn't hear the ugly voice of the war, I could leave my home in an organized manner, and I thank God that everyone I love is alive.

My journey began in Vilnius. A very small country with a very big heart. I went to Austria, France, Germany afterwards, but I didn't see such a feel for Ukraine there as I felt in Vilnius. A Lithuanian family of 2 adults, 2 kids, 2 cats and a dog became my family for a month and my dearest friends thereafter who are part of my life now. It was a lucky draw that out of all families wishing to host Ukrainian refugees I got the one with whom we have so much in common. It turned out that we are the same age, we used to live in the UAE at the same time, and all of us were involved in the aviation industry, we all love animals, we have passion for books and hiking (30 km per day is a normal thing) ... I experienced that

forgotten feeling as I had when I was a teenager and used to visit my cousins during school vacations. It was interesting to explore Lithuanian culture, cuisine and language.

During these 6 month I made new friends, could organize planned catch up with the old ones or accidentally run into people that I didn't see for several years. All these events taught me that this big world is actually very small. And when you think that you are alone, there will be someone who will give you a hand (for sure!). The best way to fight a depression is to help others. When we suffer or feel down, we are always focused on

ourselves and become egoistic little kids who want a remedy and forget about others. Be strong for your loved ones! And pictures! We should take more pictures to capture people and moments that will never come back again.

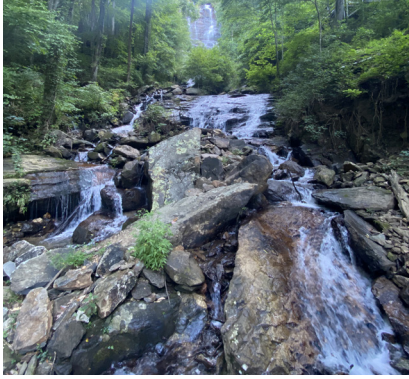
