We Were Brothers

"Whoa! Hey, what are you doing!?" Our truck suddenly stops. I see another truck has skid off the road and come to a grinding halt.

"Guys, is anybody hurt?" I ask. "We're OK!" Someone shouts back. The two trucks are carrying myself and my fellow brothers in arms down a

and my fellow brothers in arms down a country road in the mountains near Rome. We are the 3rd stormtroopers platoon of the 6th Company of the 126th Officers course of 1987: a group of battle buddies from ages 20 to 24 with a wide variety of talents and all determined to deliver important results. This was a known fact, both in and out of the battalion.

There is Gianluca, the running back of

the Giaguari Turin (Italian 1st division). He is called "the animal". Maurizio is a rugby player. He's from Rome. He does not talk much but when he does, he always_says the right thing. Fabio is a gymnast, with high hopes, from Rome. He is probably stronger than Gianluca and Maurizio combined. Roberto is an

(close to where I live now). He is not a sports champion, but he talks continuously without a break and organizes anything he finds. The biggest one in the platoon is Giuseppe, also from Rome, a talented photographer with an incredible sense of humor, and more than anything else, he is huge and very strong. He always laughs. Then Giuseppe, from Lecce, is the most shy and smallest of the group. Since we have already a Giuseppe, this one goes by Sasso (which means Stone) because he's little but always perseveres and never gives up, just like a stone. Every day he asks me, "Shall we pass this Training period?" and every day I tell him, "We keep on like this and we'll all pass it, Sasso". He is unbreakable just like the rest of us.

Gianmarco, from Verona, looks lazy and a little bit scruffy but he is the leader of the platoon. He is not the best one, but he pulls the best out of everybody and he never says "I", he always says "We". He is an expert in off-road driving. Our lieutenant checks the truck and

We were like that, we helped each other out and left nobody behind. We simply did what we were told to do, together, like a family.

At the end of our course, we won the Race¬-Boeselager long run with military

proofs that included: climbing, precision shooting, and hand grenade launches.

I win the individual race (My nickname was Crazy Horse) and once I cross the finish line, I run back along the course looking for my brothers to support them for one last push of effort. I keep on running back until I find the last of my companions, Sasso, and I start cheering him on. Gianluca, Marco, and the others do the same and we finish running with him. We reach the finish line united like we were during the 5 months we spent together: a storm! We also won the team race. We were number 1 all around!

After a few days, we all left for our assignments as officers, but we knew we were forever united. We were brothers and we did what we did because we all counted on each other: we gave everything we had and received more in return. That was our platoon. I have never forgotten those guys, and never will!

Organization Lessons:

Develop and Execute Standards

Standards are used to hold people and organizations accountable. Leaders should know the difference between hard rules and soft guidelines. There is a time and a place for both. Standards typically fall into three categories: 1) Guidelines 2) Instructions and 3) Procedures. When leaders understand the difference between these three it will help formulate the right degree of control for a given situation.

Standards should be visible and accessible. If people don't know your standards, then you can't expect them to follow them. **Execute to standards**. Have standards that make sense and are correct. Do what you say you are going to do. **Validate and maintain standards**. Get rid of the old if these no longer make sense. Duke quotes James Clear by saying, "Too often, leaders focus on goals rather than the systems they should build and nurture to achieve them." Set goals are not achievable without a well thought out system.

Align Roles to Goals

It is important that each leader look at his or her business unit regardless of size to make sure that each team member's roles are assigned to a goal. As organizations grow, misalignment starts to creep in. Alignment is what everyone does to help a team win. If a person is focused on the wrong goal, yet manages to succeed, the question then becomes, did this person really succeed? Not really. We live in a day and age of complex issues and ambiguity and with such circumstances, extra caution and diligence is required. We must ensure that what we do on a daily basis supports the individual goal as well as the goal of the team.

Actions: 1) Define Purpose, Vision, and Strategy: Leaders must connect functional roles to the organization's vision. 2) Set Goals: Do this for every business unit, division, department, team, and individual. 3) Define Roles: Each person needs to understand how their responsibility applies to the overall team. If they fail to grasp this connection, then we are not doing the right thing. 4) Post Progress Publicy: Let everyone see how the overall team is doing in reaching goals and where help might be needed. Peter Senge says, "If people do not share a common vision ... and do not share common mental models about the business reality within which they operate, empowering people will only increase organizational stress and the burden of management to maintain coherence and direction."
